Absolute location of the site: Latitude N 25° 41' 1.0788", Longitude E 91° 54'50.2632". Date of the visit: Tuesday, 14th March 2023. Weather condition of the site during the day of the visit: humidity is about 28% (sunny and dry), temperature is about 22.28°C, and altitude is about 1614m ASL
