
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(3) Report, highlighting the outcome of the activity & Geotagged photos

The SEC Culinary Club on the occasion of the NCC Annual Festival organised by the 42nd Meghalaya NCC Bn., put up stalls on the request of the Unit for two days, i.e., 11th and 12th July, 2023.

On first day, the stalls were put up from morning 11am till afternoon evening 5pm. Whereas, on the second day stalls were put up from 10am till 2pm. The food items that were sold were milk masala tea, ginger tea, custard, egg chop, kheer, chaat, pastries, cheese garlic bread, cheesecakes, chocolate chip cookies, mango sticky rice, combos of chicken fries and french fries and yellow rice and meatballs with different chutneys, lunch packets of traditional khasi food both non vegetarian and vegetarian, wraps, litchi and lemonade juice.

The stalls of the first day saw a rush of NCC cadets and senior officials thronging to buy the various delicacies prepared by the students of St. Edmund's College in spite of the weather being drizzly. The stalls garnered a healthy sales covering their expenses and also earning profit. For the second day, the stalls were able to sell their goods only to cover the expenses as the weather was rainy and windy, and only a few of the participants came to the stalls and bought the goods. In overall, it was a successful two day event for the culinary club and its members, with the stall owners complimenting for giving the opportunity to put up stalls.



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
