





Response Q1: What was the nature/mode of classes you attended?







## Response Q2: What was the approximate coverage of your syllabus?







Response Q3: What was your level of understanding during the class?







Response Q5: Did you ask questions and clear your doubts during class?





Response Q6: Did you do additional reading/discuss with your friends about your syllabus?




