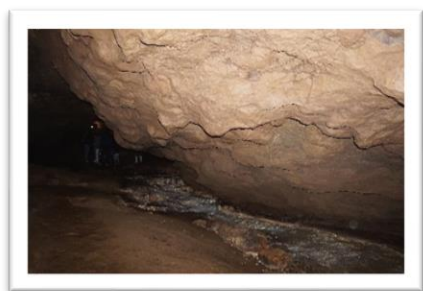
On this trip, on a different vehicle, we were accompanied by our teachers who were there to also spend a memorable day with their students and to ensuring that everything was going as per planned.

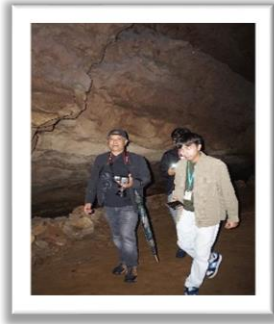
After a few hours of driving, we had a small tea break and shortly we continued back on our journey
