Admission into Master in Social Work, 2017

The Master in Social Work programme in St. Edmund's College is affiliated to North-Eastern Hill University. The duration of the course is 4 semesters.

Master in Social Work prepares graduates for active participation in social programmes, social initiatives, community programmes, community involvement etc. It is a job oriented programme and it empowers youth to active and committed social interaction through various initiatives.

ANY GRADUATE FROM ANY STREAM WITH 50% AGGREGATE IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. SELECTION WILL BE DONE AS PER THE SELECTION PROCESS BELOW:

NUMBER OF SEATS: 30 (THIRTY) + 9 (SUPERNUMERARY)

- 1.** 60% of the 30 seats will be reserved for Meghalaya Tribal students as per the norms followed by the College for other courses.
- 2. Preference and weightage:**
 - (i) Catholic students (10 points)
 - (ii) St. Edmund's BSW Graduates (12 points)
 - (iii) St. Edmund's Graduates from other streams (8 points)
 - (iv) Other BSW Graduates (10 points)
- 3. Supernumerary:**
 - a. Direct admission for candidate or personnel belonging to the Congregation of Christian Brothers and candidates or personnel belonging to priestly or religious orders of the Catholic community. A maximum of 5 seats (a policy followed for admission to all courses by the College) is reserved for this category.
 - b. Management Quota (4 seats): At the discretion of the Admission Committee.

2. The last date to send the application form is 12th July, 2017.
3. You will be informed about the entrance test and other formalities by e-mail and mobile phone. For entrance and other formalities a fee of ₹250.00 (two hundred fifty) only will be charged.

5. Application form will also be available in Counter – 2 of the College office during office hours.
