- Malinowski- Functionalist
- Made distinction between material and non-material or symbolic exchange.
- Kula exchange was not only an economic exchange but also a **symbolic exchange**, cementing a web of social relationships.

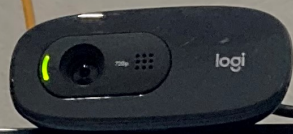
