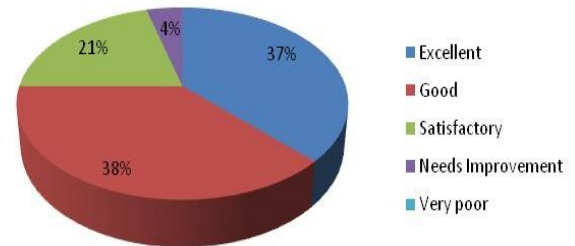
Quality of Technical Sessions



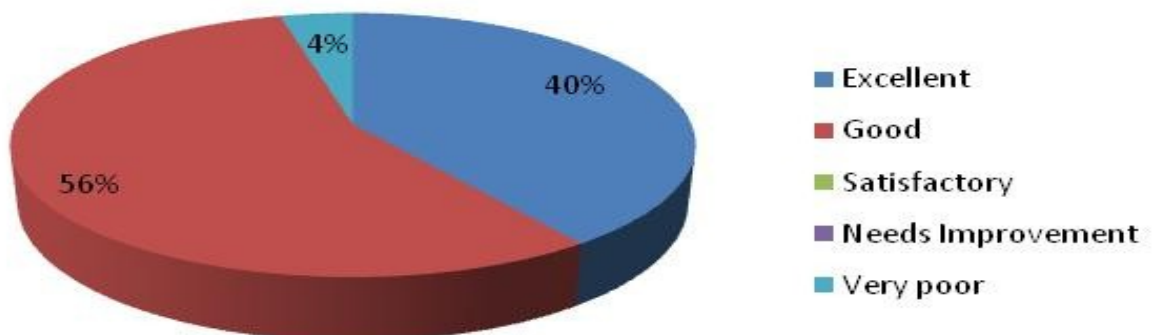

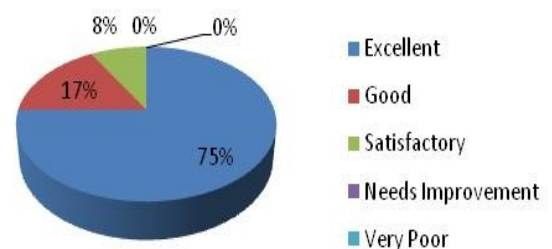

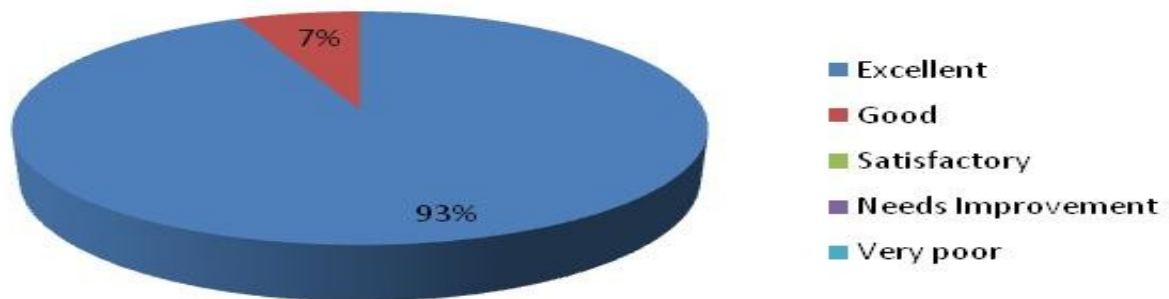
Interactions with Resource Persons

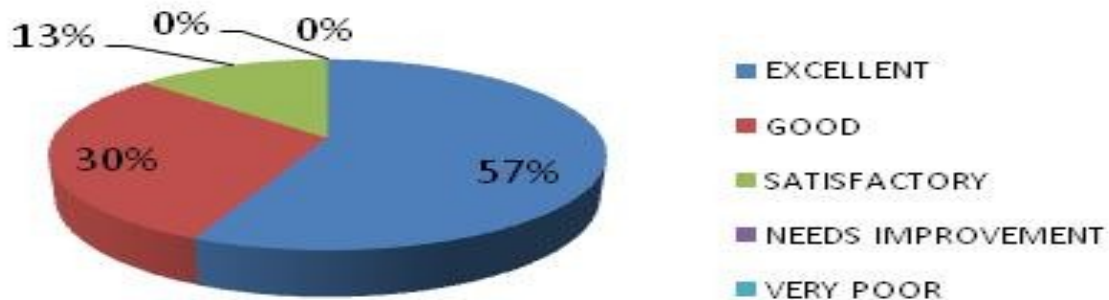

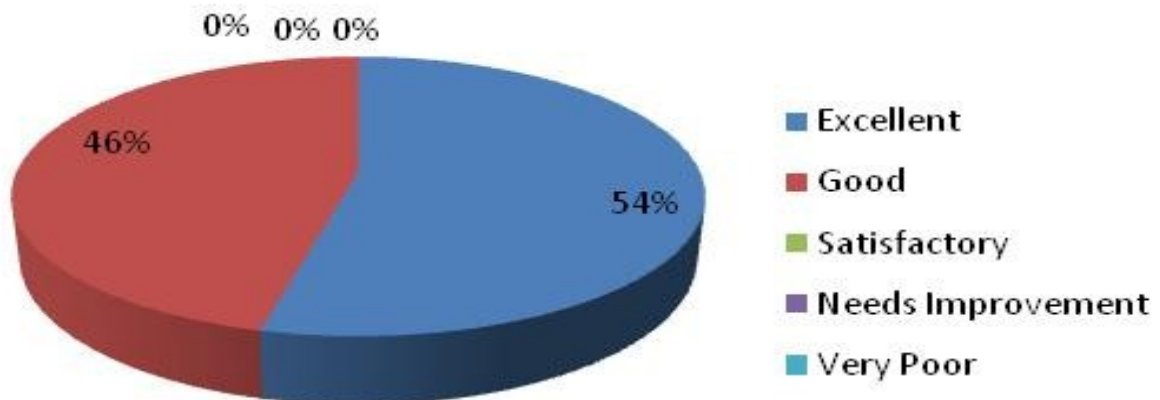
