
DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS INTERACTIVE SESSION ON CUET (PG)

17th February 2024



- To assist the 6th Semester Economics Major Students understand and prepare for the 2024 CUET (PG), the department reached out to Mr. Ethan Lyngdoh of Batch 2020 – 2023.
- Mr. Ethan spoke on the previous pattern of the exams, the nature and the number of questions from topics across the undergraduate syllabus. He stressed on the importance of preparation for the new pattern with 75 questions from Economics only.
- He gave examples of the minimum marks required for the top universities like JNU, Delhi School of Economics etc
- The interactive session, though of a short duration of only an hour, was filled with information from Ethan and questions from students.
- Forty two (42) students attended the program
- The department intends to have more of similar sessions to help Economics Major Students successfully undertake the CUET (PG) exam.











LEARNING OUTCOMES

- The reason for the interactive session was that our students were not aware of the nitty-gritties of the CUET exam like which Central Universities to choose, the cut-offs of last year, which topics require what type of preparation etc. We as faculty too picked up a lot of information
- Our Students started their preparations extremely late
- Several topics included in the syllabus of CUET examination were not included in our undergraduate syllabus
- On a request from class representatives of 6th semester, the Dept switched from Public Economics to Statistics
- Faculty of the department in their individual capacity also undertook the discussion of previous question papers
- The CUET results of 2024 for our students have not been encouraging. With the next batch we wish to ensure an early start with their preparation.
