Antaakshari, also known as Antyakshri is a spoken parlor game where each contestant sings the first verse of a song with the Hindustani consonant on which the previous consonant's song selection ended. This report is written in order to provide the gist of the entire event.

The animators namely Gourav Poddar and Arundhati Das under the guidance of Miss. Reema Joshi and Mr. Deepankar Shome who were also the judge of the program. The event started at 10:00 A.M.; there were a total of 4 participating teams who competed against each other to win the competition. There were a total of 7 rounds each with different markings namely- The Genre Antaakshari with 10 points, the word round with 10 points, the antara mukhda round with 15 points, dumb charade with 15 points being 5 points for guessing and 10 points for singing correctly, the music round with 15 points having same division of marks as dumb charade and the last audio visual round with 15 points having the same division of points as the previous two rounds. The last two rounds had a -5 marking for singing the wrong song.

After completing all the six rounds, the winner of the Antaakshari were Shubhankar Deb Roy (Leader), Arnab, Ronit Kumar Singh and Akashdeep Paul. The runners up were Dikshita Phukar(Leader), Muskan Ahmed, Ayushmi Kashyap and Angshita Kashyap and the third place holder were Lamphrang Lyngdoh (Leader), Ridabiang Sungeh, Issac and Kyrshanskhem.

The volunteers and animators did an excellent job of making the event a success and making it enjoyable for all. They ended the event with a playful round of Antaakshari with the teachers, volunteers and animators.
