## **Report on the release of "The Edmundian"– Centenary Edition 2022-23**

St Edmund's College celebrated its Centenary Year in the year 2023. As part of the year-long celebration, the Magazine Committee was able to bring out the Centenary Edition of 'The Edmundian'. This task was more challenging than the previous year because of the huge responsibility to bring out a magazine that would be unique and would provide some form of documentation of the past 100 years of the existence of the College. At first, the task appeared daunting, but with a dedicated team of students and teachers, the plan was laid and work was started. During the closing ceremony of the Centenary Celebrations on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2023 the Magazine Committee released the Cover of 'The Edmundian – Centenary Edition' along with seven messages from important personalities. The cover was designed by Wandeipor Khongtir, a student of the English Department and Cherik Momin, a student of the Department of Economics.



Among the many interesting articles in the magazine, there are a number of topics worth mentioning. The topics range from the rich history of the College, the timeline of the College from 1923 to 2023, the changing phases of the College reflected in the beautiful pictures of the past and present, the histories of each Department of the College, photographs of the Staff and the Students of the College, reports on the activities conducted by different Departments and Clubs throughout the year as part of the Centenary celebrations, interviews of some of the Alumni of the College, a number of articles and poems, a gallery of photographs of the different events from the Opening Ceremony to the Closing Ceremony of the Centenary Year along with the College Anthem and the Centenary Theme Song. It is hoped that this rich legacy of the College will inspire its readers to strife towards greater heights as the College moves forward to the next hundred or more years following the motto of the College, "Facta Non Verba", i.e. 'Deeds Not Words'.
