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GUIDELINES FOR VERITAS –

Edmundian Journal for Multidisciplinary Research (EJMR)

Aims and objectives:

VERITAS is a peer-reviewed, open-access journal publishing scientific research in all fields of Science, Technology, Arts, Humanities, and Commerce. The journal serves to provide a platform to undergraduates, researchers and faculty to publish their work, gain experience in scientific communication and contribute to the development of knowledge. Authors should note that only original and previously unpublished manuscripts will be considered. The journal publishes the following types of articles:

Review Article

Research Article

Short Communication

Case reports/studies

Scope of the journal

The journal welcomes empirical studies, theoretical papers, methodological papers, case studies, and evidence-based reviews in the disciplines listed above. Manuscripts must present clear objectives, sound methodology, and well-supported conclusions. Purely opinion-based or promotional pieces without scholarly content will not be considered.

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- Associate Editors representing major disciplinary clusters
- Editorial Office/Editorial Board

The Editor-in-Chief has the final responsibility for editorial decisions. Associate Editors coordinate peer review in their subject areas. Board members may act as reviewers and provide strategic advice.

Screening

Upon reception of an article, the Editorial Staff will initially screen the article for journal scope, adherence to formatting guidelines, originality and ethical compliance. If the article is not up to the standard format, the article will be returned to the author for correcting the format.

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VARITAS follows a double-blinded peer review process with identities of authors and reviewers concealed from each other. Each manuscript (that passes screening) is typically sent to at least two reviewers with relevant subject expertise. Based on reviewers' comments, the Editor-in-Chief/Associate Editor makes one of the following decisions: Accept/ Accept with minor revisions/ Revise and resubmit (major revisions)/reject.

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reviewer/editor comments. The Editor-in-Chief/Chief's may seek an additional independent review, and the decision after appeal will be final. Appeals will only be considered for manuscripts that have been peer-reviewed and will not be considered for those rejected outright by the journal editorial team. The appeal must be submitted by the corresponding author of the manuscript. All authors must agree to the submission of the appeal.

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Instruction To The Authors

Manuscript Structure

All portions of the manuscript must be in standard English text (UK), plain font (e.g., 12-point Times Roman and double-spaced) and all pages numbered starting from the title page. The Title Should be brief describing the contents of the paper. The Abstract should be informative and completely self-explanatory, briefly present the topic, state the scope of the experiments, indicate significant data, and point out major findings and conclusions. It should be of around 150-200 words. The Keywords should be just below the abstract and between 3 to 5. The main body of the **manuscript** should include:

Introduction

Materials and Methods

Result

Discussion

Conclusion.

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For **review and short communications** the submitted manuscript should focus or cover a broader topic. The review manuscript should contain:

Abstract

Introduction

Discussion

The Discussion can be broken down into sub-sections, and a Summary and Outlook section, in which the achievements and new challenges for the subject are presented succinctly. The length of the manuscript between a Review and Short communication will vary with the review covering the content in its entirety.

Short Communications can be brief reports that present original and significant research. It may focus on a hot topic or may have new findings that are expected to have a significant impact on a current problem.

Case reports/studies can include new, interesting, and rare cases that can be reported. It should be unique, describing a great diagnostic or therapeutic challenge and providing a learning point for the readers. It can be real-world scenarios (individuals, events, organizations) to test theories or explore themes, focusing on business, on society/culture, and on creative/cultural impact.

Tables and Figures should be numbered consecutively. Citation of tables and figures should use the following format: Table 1, Table 2, etc. Figure 1, Figure 2, etc. (Parts in a figure can be identified by A, B, C, D, and cited as Figure 1A, Figure 1B, Figure 1C etc. Tables should be created/formatted using Microsoft Word table format and they must be editable. Tables in Image format will not be accepted. Both Tables and Figures should be included at the end of the manuscript with captions and the images should be of the highest resolution (minimum 300 dpi) and any letters inside should be clear and legible. All table columns should have an explanatory heading. To facilitate the copy-editing of larger tables, smaller fonts (no smaller than 8 pt.) may be used. Authors should use the “Table” option in Microsoft Word to create tables.

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Scientific names should be in italics (Example: *Psidium guajava* L.) and write in full form (Both genus and species) following the international nomenclature in the title of the manuscript as well as at the first mention in a paper. After the first mention, the first letter of the genus name followed by the full species name can be used (e.g., *P. guajava*). SI Units (International System of Units) should be used throughout the manuscript.

Standard abbreviations should be used throughout the manuscript. All nonstandard abbreviations should be kept to a minimum and must be defined in the text following their first use.

References in the text should be cited by name followed by the year of publication and the reference list entries should be alphabetized at the end of the manuscript. Two or more works by the same author in the same year must be differentiated by the addition of 'a', 'b', 'c' etc., after the year of publication. In-text citations include the author and year (Ashwathy and Krishnakumar, 2020). Study reported by more than two authors should be cited with "et al.", "and the groups of references should be listed chronologically (order by year of publication, the earlier one first) and separated by semicolons (Chamle et al., 2011; Kumar et al., 2013; Lone et al., 2018). Referencing list is in the alphabetical order. Referencing for publication by the author in the same year to be suffixed as a/b/c. Referencing style for sciences is to done following Vancouver style referencing and for Humanities/Arts/Commerce as MLA (Modern Language Association) of referencing
