TIME: 10.30 AM-3.00 PM


A food fest was organised by the Culinary Club, St Edmund's college, Shillong, on the occasion of College week i.e, Edblazon 2023, dated 17. 02. 2023 at the college premises. There were a total of 20 stalls comprising 3-5 participants each. The food items were categorised as traditional, continental, snacks, desserts and beverages, and bakery. Inauguration of the event took place at 10:30 a.m. that was done by Prof. Monotosh Chakraborty, Vice principal (Administration). Following this at around 11:00 a.m. the program started with the judgement of stalls by teachers from different departments. This competition was organised to test the student's teamwork, collaboration and creativity in terms of food preparation and presentation. The idea behind was to teach them the entrepreneurship skills.

Immediately after the judgement, the event was made open for all, where the students of the college, the faculty members and other guests were allowed to purchase and try the dishes from the various stalls. The price range for most of the food items were in between Rs 30 & Rs. 40. The participants were able to provide good quality and delicious food at an affordable price. Each and every customer was seen to be highly satisfied with the food quality. In fact, in some of the stalls, the food items were sold out within just half an hour. All the participants maintained proper cleanliness and hygiene of the stalls.

Every stall did well and the students worked really hard, however based on the taste, quality and presentation the prize was given to only three stalls.

The event was a great success in terms of a wide variety of food items and creative decoration of stalls from each class and was appreciated by everyone. The program came to an end at around 3:30 p.m.

The Culinary Club in collaboration with the Art Club put up a stall on 20th of February, 2023 on the occasion of Edblazon 2023 at College Cafeteria, St. Edmund's College. The stalls were put up from around 10:00 am morning that went up to 2:00 pm. There were two stalls and the food items sold comprised of Laphing, Spring Roll, Sweet Corn, fries, Hot Chocolate Drink, Pakora, Pastries, Aloo Muri Chat, Jeera Juice and Mimi Singju.

The food items that were loved by all especially the two traditional items i.e. laphing (which is a traditional Tibetan dish that looks like a roll-made from all purpose flour and filled with a delicate mixture which has a very distinct flavour of chilly oil and garlic) and mimi singju (which is a famous snack of Manipur made up of a mixture of green leafy vegetables, dried fish powder, perilla powder, black salt, onion, dried chillies, chickpeas, lime juice and mimi) This was its first official collaboration with another club since establishment and acted as a source of motivation for participation as more of students are willing to put up food stalls during similar college events.

Workshop on Salad Designing

A workshop on Salad Designing was organised by the Culinary Club of St. Edmund's College, on 15th May 2023 with Dr. Sanjiban Goswami, HoD Botany Department as the resource person. There was 18 participants altogether. The event was graced Dr. Br. Simon Coelho, Principal-in-Charge; Prof Monotosh Chakraborty, Vice-Principal (Administration); Dr. K P Pallavi Malhan, Vice-Principal (Academics), Dr. B W Nongbri (Dean); along with faculty members and students from other departments. The workshop commenced with a welcome speech delivered by Debanjan Tarafdar, President of the club followed by speech from Principal and Vice-Principal (Academics). After this Dr. Sanjiban Goswami, took over the dais and demonstrated for three types of salad making using

1. eggs and salad leaves,
2. cucumbers and tomatoes, and
- 3 onions, carrots and cucumbers.

It was a hands on training with resource person teaching the participants on ways to make a rabbit with eggs and cloves and grass with lettuce leaves. He then taught them on making of swans using tomato and cloves followed by flower designing using cucumbers, onions and carrot leaves. It was very interactive and the resource person was also helping students and clearing their doubts that they were facing while designing.

Finally, the workshop concluded, with concluding remarks from Prof. Monotosh Chakravarty, Vice-Principal (Administration), followed by vote of thanks delivered by Tanisha Saikia, one of the Core Committee Members of the Club.

3. They look forward for more of programmes of this nature like workshop on vegetable printing, fruit salad designs & baking classes; and also to participate in different competitions organised by the club.

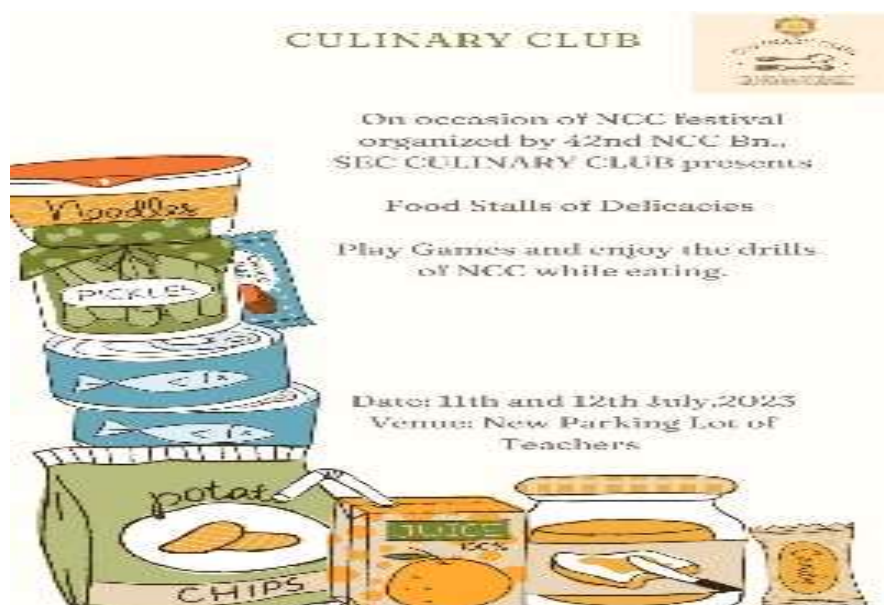
Food Stalls of Delicacies

On first day, the stalls were put up from morning 11 am till 5 pm. Whereas, on the second day, stalls were put up from 10 am till 2 pm. The food items sold were milk masala tea, ginger tea, custard, egg chop, kheer, chaat, pastries, cheese garlic bread, cheesecakes, chocolate chip cookies, mango sticky rice, combos of chicken fries and french fries and yellow rice and meatballs with different chutneys, lunch packets of traditional khasi food both non vegetarian and vegetarian, wraps, litchi and lemonade juice.

The members of the Culinary Club of St. Edmund's College organised a 'No Flame Cooking Competition' on 25th September, 2023 to commemorate National Cooking Day. It was for the first time that cooking competition was organised within the college premises by the Culinary Club ever since its existence in the college. Participation was allowed in individual (1 member) and also in a team (with maximum 3 members). The Competition was held at College Auditorium around 1:20 p.m. and went off for around 2 hours, during which time the participants were asked to prepare their respective dishes and get them ready for presentation. In total there were 17 teams comprising of 43 participants in aggregate.

Dishes prepared included various types of chats, sandwiches, beverages, bread cakes, sandwiches, etc. Participants were required to use only uncooked raw materials and usage of pre-cooked items were restricted. The objective behind was to test the students' teamwork, collaboration and creativity in food preparation. It was open to all faculty members, students and the non-teaching staff to watch the competition and grace it as audience.

Judgement of the preparations started at around 3:20 p.m. There were a total of 5 judges namely Dr. Ronald Lyngdoh Tron, Dr. Jasmine Sawian, Dr. Sanjiban Goswami, Prof. Rajni Khyriem, Dr. Rituparna Rajendra. The set criteria for judging were taste, quality, creativity, hygiene and presentation; on the basis of which marks were awarded and the winners were declared accordingly.

The event was also graced by Principal in-charge, Dr. Br. Simon Coelho, and the Vice Principal (Administration), Prof. Monotosh Chakravarty by their presence.

The event came to an end at around 3:45 p.m., and was greatly appreciated by everyone. The event was a great success in terms of the variety of food items and creative presentations. The participants exceeded everyone's expectations with the quality and creativity put into their dishes.

9. Participants are required to minimize wastage of food items/ingredients.
10. Minimize the use of plastic.
11. Participants should make the dish/beverage enough to plate for 5 people.
12. The participants will be judged on the basis of taste, quality, and presentation.
13. Participants should maintain hygiene and safety.
14. Time limit is 2 hours.
15. Boiled items can be used.
16. Participants are to bring their own materials and utensils.
