The Culinary Club of St. Edmund's college, Shillong, organized a Salad Designing Competition on the occasion of college week i.e EDBLAZON 2024 held on 24th February 2024 in the college premises. The event aimed at promoting culinary artistry and also to provide a platform to the students to showcase their creativity in terms of presentation, those who participated in *the Salad Designing Workshop* hosted by the same club, in the previous year.

A total of 13 students (paired up in 5 groups) participated in the competition and their enthusiasm and passion for culinary creativity were evident in their salad creations. Inauguration of the event was done at around 11.am, following which the participants were required to make their respective salad preparations, within a given time limit of two hours.

The judging panel consisted of Dr. Sanjiban Goswami, HOD of Botany Department who evaluated the salads based on criteria such as presentation, designing, creativity & innovation and also on the basis of cleanliness & hygiene. The judging session started around 1:15pm and some questions such as "what is the scientific name of cucumber and importance of carrots in our daily life" were asked by Dr. Sanjiban to the participants. The participants displayed unique types of both vegetable and fruit salads such as farm fantasy, peacock salad, etc. They also explained the speciality of their salads and the importance of including it in our daily diet. Special emphasis was given on the hygiene considerations and the culinary tools used while preparing and dressing of the final product.

With Dr.Sanjiban's expertise, he ensured a fair and thorough assessment of each salad and the top three salad were chosen and the prize distribution was held on the very same day. Special thanks to Dr. Dipankar Shome as the whole event was coordinated under his guidance.

The Culinary Club of St. Edmund's college, Shillong, organized a Food fest Competition on the occasion of college week i.e EDBLAZON 2024 held on 26th February 2024 in the college premises. This event aimed at embracing the rich diverse culinary culture and heritage of different regions, promoting unity and teamwork qualities as well as providing a platform for aspiring food enthusiasts and entrepreneurs.

At 11:00 am, the inauguration of the event took place which was done by Br. Benjamin (Principal, St. Edmund's Higher Secondary) along with Dr.Br.Simon Coelho (Principal) and Prof.Monotosh Chakravarty (Vice Principal, Administration). In all, there were 34 stalls (including 2 stalls set up for charity purpose and a special stall set up by a Teacher) comprising of 4 participants each. In aggregate, there were 128 participants. The food items were categorized into 9 types-Traditional, Asian, Mexican, Continental, Mediterranean, Desserts, Bakery, Snacks and Beverages. Some of the dishes were Kimbap, Dohneiiong, Wak Kapa, Crepes, Fruit Salad, etc. The Judging panel consisted of 7 teachers- Dr.Jasmine T. Sawian, Dr.Rituparna Rajendra, Miss Larihun Jeengaph, Miss Ainamlin Dkhar, Dr.Sanjiban Goswami, Dr.Jayanti

At around 11.15 am, the judges set on their culinary adventure as the judging session started and each of the stalls were evaluated based on criteria such as captions, knowledge of the recipe, taste, texture, aroma/flavor, creativity/uniqueness, and overall presentation/appearance. All the judges were quite satisfied with preparations and presentations of food stuffs made by each of the stalls. Dr.Jasmine, one of the judges also commented on the uniqueness of "The Royal Taste of Tripura" stall and rich taste of 'Chak-Hao Kheer' (dish) from "Ene Gi Potfam" stall.

Following this, the stalls were opened to all the students, faculty and teachers to purchase and the taste the food preparations. It was decided that price should not exceed ₹ 100 and also a mandatory rule of making availability of packaging service. Every customer was seen to be satisfied with the large variety of food choices, different cuisines and the stalls could sufficiently fulfil the food demand from the whole college. All the stalls maintained hygiene and cleanliness and it was evident that many enjoyed the event as the venue had transformed into a bustling culinary hub.
