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FIRST SEMESTER ELECTIVE SUBJECTS

MULTI-DISCIPLINARY COURSE (MDC)

You will need to choose one from the following:

1. **MDC 110 COMMERCIAL ARITHMETIC AND ELEMENTARY STATISTICS:** The course will familiarize students with knowledge of essential mathematics and statistics that are applicable to real-life business situations.
2. **MDC 111 CULTURE AND SOCIETY:** The course will examine concepts and theories related to culture along with understanding the socio-cultural diversity of India and North-East India.
3. **MDC 112 FUNDAMENTALS OF COMPUTER SYSTEMS:** The course will involve comprehension of basic information related to hardware and software, number systems, types of operating systems and networks.
4. **MDC 113 FUNDAMENTALS OF EARTH SYSTEM SCIENCE:** The course provides comprehensive knowledge about planet Earth, geological processes and the formation of minerals and rocks.
5. **MDC 114 FUNDAMENTALS OF LIFELONG LEARNING:** The course will examine concepts of lifelong learning and throw light on government programmes on lifelong learning for youth, women, farmers, etc.
6. **MDC 115 INTRODUCTORY LIFE SCIENCES:** The course aims to familiarize students with concepts of biodiversity and conservation, the origin of life, and classification of life forms and the process of evolution.
7. **MDC 116 INTRODUCTION TO NATIONAL CADET CORPS:** This course introduces the National Cadet Corps, covering its evolution and India's defence system aiming to shape young minds by fostering courage and a secular outlook.



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8. **MDC 117 INTRODUCTION TO PSYCHOLOGY:** The course will identify basic concepts of psychology and examine the relationship between the physical functioning of an organism and its behaviour, including pro-social behaviour.
9. **MDC 118 MATHEMATICS IN DAILY LIFE:** The course will familiarize students with everyday banking transactions, data interpretation and perform basic calculations.
10. **MDC 119 PHILOSOPHY OF CULTURE:** The course will impart the basics of human culture and incorporate belief systems, tribal cultures from North-East India and Indian Culture, along with a focus on the decolonization of knowledge.

SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSE (SEC)

You will need to choose one from the following:

1. **SEC 130 CYBER SECURITY:** The course will help students perform malware and spam e-mail identification, virus scanning and other services using security tools and various existing cyber laws.
2. **SEC 131 MOTIVATION:** The course will demonstrate different aspects on



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how people are motivated and create in the students, conditions in which they are willing to learn and work with zeal, initiative, interest, and enthusiasm.

3. **SEC 132 PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT:** The course will comprehend the scope of personality, enable the development of core skills for development of positive personality traits, and cultivating skills for successful life.
4. **SEC 133 PUBLIC SPEAKING:** The course will enable the students to overcome the fear of public speaking and enhance their confidence to gain practical experience in effective public speaking.
5. **SEC 134 TEAM BUILDING:** The course will help students to understand the importance of team building and learn how team building helps in conflict resolution, management and the use of individual talents.

SECOND SEMESTER ELECTIVE SUBJECTS

MULTIDISCIPLINARY COURSE (MDC)

You will need to choose one from the following:

MDC 160 DISASTER MANAGEMENT: The course will explain the fundamentals of disaster management and develop critical thinking in terms of response, preparedness and mitigation strategies in all phases of disaster.

MDC 161 ENTREPRENEURSHIP: The course will provide exposure to the students to the concept and process of entrepreneurship, and industrial growth so as to prepare them to set up their own small enterprises.



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MDC 162 ENVIRONMENTAL ETHICS: The course will promote sensitivity to larger issues of environment and climate crisis, how to go about restoration and recycling and other such ethical means of preserving the environment.

MDC 163 FUNDAMENTALS OF STATISTICS: The course will impart to the students knowledge on the development, meaning, importance and scope of Statistics, descriptive measures of data and concepts of probability.

MDC 165 INTRODUCTION TO EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY: The course will sensitize students towards the applications of psychological concepts and principles in education in order to improve educational practice.

MDC 166 INTRODUCTION TO THEATRE AND PERFORMANCE: The course will sensitize students to gain the basics of theatre and performance and the ability to translate dramatic theory into practice.

MDC 167 PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORTS SCIENCE: The course will provide general concept of physical education, the impact of physical activities on our vital physiological systems and provide information about Sports Bodies of India.

MDC 168 PHYSICAL GEOLOGY AND GEODYNAMICS: The course will familiarise students with the internal structure of the Earth, endogenetic processes, deformation in the rocks and the principles of Stratigraphy and its correlation.

MDC 169 UNDERSTANDING HUMAN RIGHTS: The course will enable students to understand the historical growth of human rights and demonstrate awareness in international and national contexts.



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SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSE

You will need to choose one from the following:

SEC 180 COMMUNICATION SKILLS: The course will help students to comprehend the fundamentals of communication, assess the importance of communication and equip themselves with communication skills.

SEC 181 CONFIDENCE BUILDING: The course will help students to explore the concept of self-confidence and enable the students to develop strategies, tools and techniques to build a positive self-image.

SEC 182 E-COMMERCE: The course will provide exposure to students on e-commerce and understand the major issues associated with online marketing, e-finance and cyber security.

SEC 183 PYTHON PROGRAMMING: The course will introduce Python programming language as multipurpose programming language with features and applications.
