OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAMME:

The history of the village began way back in 1898, when the forefathers wanted to keep a memorial stone of a grand lady whose name was "İawet" and hence the name of the place became Mawiawet; in today's time. There are a total of 140 houses in the village which is home to a total population of 843. The strength of the male is at 415 which the females exceed as their count is at 428 out of the total population. The activities carried out by the Student Social Workers are Community Profiling, Home visits, Transect walk, School visits and activities, Visiting the construction sites and interviewing the labour workers, Vermi-composting awareness programme, follow- up on programme of Vermi- composting and fund raising. From this fieldwork enabled the student social worker to have a community experience and apply their theoretical knowledge and bring it to practice. It enhanced the skills of the student social worker and helped her to make use of a number of principles and tools of social work as well as community organization.

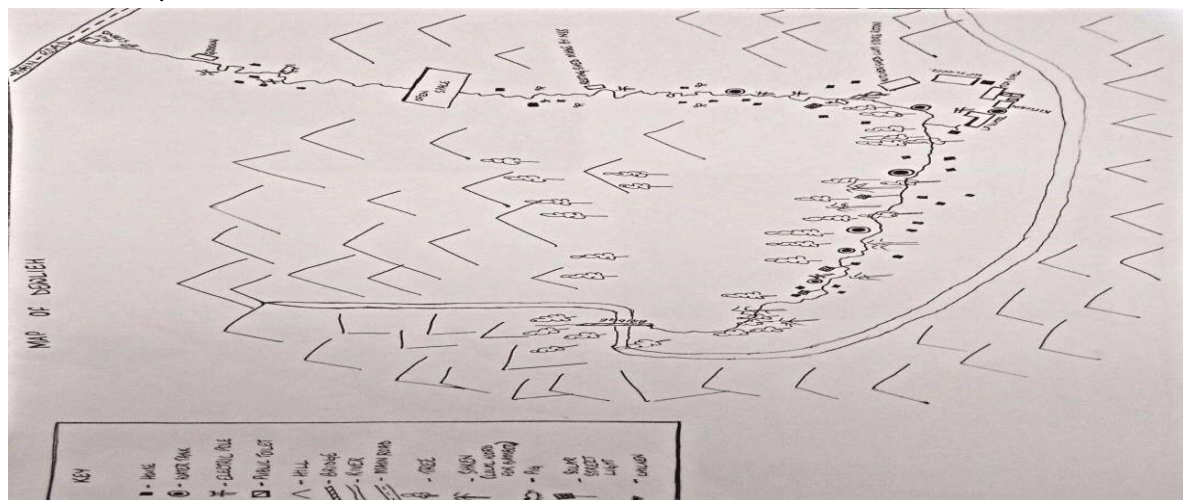

OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAMME:

Dewlieh Village is located in Khadar Shnong, East Khasi Hills District. The Student Social Workers had to walk almost 3000 stairs to reach the village and 6000 stairs till the end of the village where there is a bridge leading to another village. There is a river below the bridge which adds beauty to the village. There are 33 households in the village with 1 L.P. School and 1 U.P. School in the village. There are 82 males and 72 females in the village. There are no religious institutions. 82% of the population follows the indigenous faith and only 2% are Christians. The Student Social Workers conducted a number of activities during their fieldwork. The main activities were Participatory Rural Appraisal, Home Visits and Awareness programme to the school children on Good Touch and Bad touch. From their fieldwork the students learnt on coordination with the contacting key person of the village, they learned about the people and the lifestyle. They learnt on the importance of team work in order to accomplish their goals and also how to accept each other.

OUTCOME OF THE FIELDWORK PLACEMENT:

The student social workers were placed at Ganesh Das Hospital, Lawmali for the fieldwork program on family planning.. Ganesh Das was established in 1935 and is one of the oldest hospitals in the state of Meghalaya that has been providing health care services throughout the state. It is funded by National Health Mission and practices various schemes developed by the government like JSY, JSSK, and MHIS etc. The student social workers were part of various activities and orientations in that programme. From their fieldwork sessions at Ganesh Das hospital, the student social workers had the following learning outcomes. The students learnt more about the topic of family planning itself and its importance in people's life. They got to know about the hospitals layout and the various wards and rooms (Antenatal room, IUCD room, etc)As Per the action plan prepared by the students undertook activities such as making charts, placards and questionnaire based on the objectives for the survey, recording data on registers, ward visits, counsel training, interview etc. Through these they gained more insight on people's say on family planning and contraceptive methods. They learned how to collaborate and work as a group irrespective of how different their thoughts might be. Everyone took active participation in every program and assignment.

Sordar Singh Ronghang and his wife Rehsina Teron along with Risubar Hanse and his wife Tisila Teron were the first to establish Khlieh - Umstem village. They were also the first to set the Presbyterian faith and customs in the village and ever since, the village have adopted only one kind of faith and customs. The Student Social Workers conducted various activities in the village. The main activities are Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA), home visits, awareness programme on Importance of cleanliness in schools and sports and games to the children and youths in the community. From these activities the student social workers had learned to cooperate among co-workers and to build understanding and closeness with the people in the community. They had learned to apply their theoretical study into actual practice. This had helped them understand social work in a broader perspective.

But indeed in the end the social workers were able to handle such challenges and issues faced so it has bring about some changes to the domestic workers in a sense that they were able to get some possible help from the organization and from the social workers.

OUTCOME OF THE PLACEMENT:

The Meghalaya State Rural Livelihoods Society is registered under the Meghalaya Society Registration Act XII of 1983. The primary purpose of this society is to put in place a dedicated and support from the state level down to the sub-district level which will focus on building strong and self-managed institution of the poor at different levels. During the fieldwork the student social workers learnt about National Rural Livelihoods Mission (NRLM). Its main aim is to alleviate rural poverty and create sustainable livelihood opportunities for the rural underprivileged people. Towards this objective, NRLM seeks to promote sustainable community- based institutions which will facilitate provision of financial services, economic services and other entitlements to the underprivileged. The student social workers also learnt that as per the guidelines of the NRLM, the government of Meghalaya has formed a state society in the name - Meghalaya State Rural Livelihood Society (MSRLS) Under MSRLS, there is a District Management Unit and a Block Management Unit and it encourages and advocates for the formation of SHGs. The student social workers also learnt that an SHG is an informal group and it is registered under Societies Act. It is a group of 10-15 underprivileged people who may or may not have the same socio-economic status, who has more or less similar problems who live nearby and come together with unity, trust, understanding of self-help and shared responsibility to achieve the common goal of overcoming poverty. The student social workers also learnt how weekly, general and executive meetings of SHGs are held. They have also learnt through various training programs on finance management and auditing and they also understood the main purpose of forming an SHG and the roles it plays in providing a decent livelihood to the members especially, in unforeseen circumstance.
