The National Health Mission, Meghalaya, Office of the DMHO, East Khasi Hills District, Meghalaya, Block Development Office, Mylliem Block, and Block Programme Management Unit, Pomlum Primary Health Centre jointly organized the Health Mela at Rangbihbih Village on 20th April 2022.
