St. Edmund's College Policy for Green Campus

1. Introduction

- Reduce the College's carbon footprint

4. Implementation Strategies

4.1 Campus Greening

- Plant at least 1000 trees in the Umroi extension campus this year.
- Establish a tree-planting program involving students, staff, and the local community.
- Develop and implement a campus greening plan to increase vegetation cover.

4.2 Energy Efficiency

- Conduct a comprehensive energy audit to identify areas for improvement.
- Replace traditional lighting with energy-efficient LED lights.
- Optimize ventilation and air conditioning systems.

- Upgrade to energy-efficient appliances and equipment.
- Implement power management practices.
- Install a 20 KW solar power system to generate clean energy.

4.3 Waste Management
